A group of Cross Links volunteers will be traveling to Moldova in September and October 2007. The group includes youth and adults, and will be led by board member Philip Yoder.

This group is planning to visit numerous village schools in Moldova where they will interact with students and teachers and then distribute school kits to needy children. Recently, 4,200 school kits arrived in Moldova as part of a larger shipment from Cross Links. These school kits are in Chisinau now, and will be distributed by the group in October.

Most of the schools in rural Moldova have no sports equipment, and the group plans to carry with them and also purchase in Moldova some sports equipment to leave with the schools they visit.

This group also plans to distribute shoes, clothing items, food, and other aid items as they travel to different places in Moldova. They will be visiting at least two orphanages and numerous churches, so there will be ample opportunity to share these items with those who are in need.

As with all of the Cross Links' groups that visit Moldova, the goals of this trip are to build friendships, to learn about life in Moldova, to distribute aid and help those in need, to support churches in their ministries, and to give hope and encouragement to the people they meet.
